

## APPLYING FOR AN MA AT MIDDLESEX UNIVERSITY LONDON

### MA in Professional Practice in Dyslexia and Literacy

#### Students who have completed Dyslexia Action Professional Diploma in Dyslexia and Literacy

Students who have successfully completed the **Dyslexia Action Diploma** programme and have gained 120 Middlesex University credits, can apply to undertake the **MA in Professional Practice in Dyslexia and Literacy** through the work-based learning programme at Middlesex University. Students will already have completed Module F with Dyslexia Action and have a draft Project Proposal in place. They will then progress to complete the 60 credit project module with Middlesex University. This will entail gaining ethical approval for your proposed project.

**Achievement of a Master's Degree** by completion of the following:

- a) 120 credits of a Dyslexia Action postgraduate professional course- Accredited by Middlesex University (Includes Module F: Research in Language and Learning (Research Methodology and Dissertation Proposal- 20 credits @ level 7
- b) **Negotiated WBL Project module- 60 credits @ level 7 with Middlesex University (WBS 4760)**

#### Students who have completed 80 credits of a Dyslexia Action Professional Certificate programme

Students who have successfully completed 80 Middlesex University credits, can apply to undertake the Middlesex University **Postgraduate Diploma in Professional Practice in Dyslexia and Literacy** through the work-based learning programme at Middlesex University.

**Achievement of a Postgraduate Diploma** by completion of the following:

- a) 80 credits of the Dyslexia Action postgraduate professional course (accredited by MUL)
- b) **Advanced Practitioner Inquiry module-30 credits @level 7 with Middlesex University (WBS 4630)**
- c) **Negotiated WBL Project module-10 credits @level 7 with Middlesex University (WBS 4710)**

The Middlesex accredited Dyslexia Action modules are ALL 20 credits at level 7 and include the following:

- Module A: Perspectives of Dyslexia and Literacy
- Module B: Principles of Assessment for Dyslexia and Literacy
- Module C: Structured Teaching Intervention for Dyslexia and Literacy
- Module D: Assessment of Literacy Related Difficulties
- Module E: Assessment of Specific Learning Difficulty (Dyslexia)
- Module F\*: Research in Language and Learning

\*required module for progression to Masters programme if the Middlesex Advanced Practitioner Inquiry module is not taken

#### Students who have completed a Dyslexia Action York Accredited Course

Students who have gained 60 credits on the Dyslexia Action York Accredited **Certificate programme** should apply for the Dyslexia Action Bridging Module followed by the [Professional Certificate in Assessment Practice for Dyslexia and Literacy](#) . They can then either proceed to Module F or to the Advanced Practitioner Enquiry module with Middlesex followed by the MA route.

Students who have studied on the Dyslexia Action York Accredited **Diploma programme** can apply directly to the MA Programme. Candidates should have a minimum of 90 credits at Level 7. As credit has been gained over 5 years ago your application will need to show evidence of current use and practice within the subject area.

**Achievement of the Master's Degree** by completion of the following:

- a) 90 credits of a Dyslexia Action University of York Postgraduate course
- b) Advanced Practitioner Inquiry module-30 credits @ level 7 with Middlesex University (WBS 4630)**
- c) Negotiated WBL Project Module- 60 credits @level 7 with Middlesex University (WBS 4760)**
