

LEVEL 5 SPECIALIST TEACHER TRAINING ROUTE	Complete ONE CPD Pathway Certificate Each comprising 6 Units (2 Awards)	Followed by Level 5 Teaching Certificate 3 Units, 8-10 months	= LEVEL 5 DIPLOMA (DADIP61)
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CPD Level 4 AND 5 Pathway to L5 Diploma

Choose this route if:

- You require a more flexible route to specialist teacher status and you can commit to 3-5 hours a week for the CPD courses
- 10 hours a week for the specialist teaching programme (DACRT60)
- You do not wish to study for a Masters course.

Level 4 Certificate in Supporting Literacy in Learners with Dyslexia (DACRT51)

- Suitable for those working in primary/secondary educational setting
- Certificate is made up of 6 units (2 awards)

Level 5 Certificate in Supporting Adults with Dyslexia and Literacy (DACRT56)

- Suitable for those working with Adults and in an FE/HE educational setting
- Certificate is made up of 6 units (2 awards)

Level 4 Certificate in Supporting International Learners with Dyslexia (DACRT67)

- Suitable for those working in a primary/secondary educational setting overseas
- Certificate is made up of 6 units (2 awards)

Level 5 Specialist SpLD Teacher Training (DACRT60)

Certificate in Strategic Teaching Support for Dyslexia and Literacy (DACRT60)

Level 5 Diploma in Strategic Teaching Support for Dyslexia and Literacy (DADIP61)
(Level 4 or 5 CPD Pathway Certificate plus Level 5 Certificate in Strategic Teaching Support (DACRT60))

Confers eligibility for:
ADG (Dyslexia Guild)
ATS /ATS FE_HE/APS (BDA)

If you wish to move on from the L5 Diploma to Assessment, you will need to complete a Bridging Module then go to: Certificate in Assessment Practice.

Choose this route if:

- You are looking for a more intensive course and wish to work towards an MA and:
- You can commit to up to 20 hours a week study for the course
- You wish to gain University credits at level 7

Level 7 Specialist Teacher Training

Professional Certificate in Structured Teaching Intervention for Dyslexia and Literacy (Level 7)
Modules A, B and C (20 credits each)

Confers eligibility for:
ADG (Dyslexia Guild)
ATS /ATS FE_HE/APS (BDA)

Level 7 Specialist Teacher/ Assessor Training

Professional Certificate in Assessment Practice for Dyslexia and Literacy (Level 7)
Module B, D and E (20 credits each)

Confers eligibility for:
MDG (Dyslexia Guild)
Assessment Practising Certificate (APC)
AMBDA / AMBDA FE/HE (BDA) (with Module C2)

Professional Diploma in Dyslexia and Literacy (Level 7)
Complete Module F (20 credits)

- Modules A – F make up the Diploma and confers eligibility for 120 HE credits from Middlesex University.
- A further 60 credits lead to the MEd Professional Practice in Dyslexia and Literacy
